Palazzo Balladoro has classical lines: the entrance portal is arched with ashlar walls, while on the main floor there is a Sanmichelian balcony. The central axis of the building is marked by a French window with a raised tympanum. Subsequently, Adriano Cristofoli carried out internal adaptation works. Today the Hall of Honor is perfectly preserved, with the ceiling and walls decorated with frescoes in 1780 by Pio Piatti and Carlo Ederle. The subject of the ceiling is "The virtues chase the vice" while on the walls there are architectures and monochrome statues. In the first courtyard of the palace it is possible to see three recently restored sundials.
